Why NO Dogs in Wilderness Parks?

- **Dogs are predators.** Wildlife becomes stressed when they smell an intruding dog. It has been shown that, in the wild, bobcats, deer and other animals will avoid places that a dog has marked. This can make it harder for wildlife to find food.
- **Domestic dog scent disrupts the lives of gray foxes and coyotes,** who also mark their territories.
- **Dogs scare native birds,** like the California Quail, from their nests, which can cause the death of their young.
- **Dogs can pick up ticks in the park.** Western black-legged ticks can give you and your dog **Lyme disease.** Ticks may carry other diseases, like **Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever.**
- Dogs can pick up **poison oak** and transfer the toxic oil to you and your family.
- The park is home to rattlesnakes. **Dogs are susceptible to rattlesnake bites.**

Most of Orange County has been developed. Only a few places remain as home for our wildlife. Domestic dogs have a home and many places to go. Help us keep Laguna Coast Wilderness wild.
